CODE OF CONDUCT & GUIDELINES

1. Only students who are part of the 2010 San Dieguito Academy graduating class may attend.
2. Any graduating student who has been expelled from school or removed from graduation ceremonies for inappropriate behavior will not be allowed to attend SDAF Grad Nite. The ticket price will not be refunded.
3. **Any use or possession of alcoholic beverages, tobacco or illicit drugs** will not be tolerated. Parents will be notified immediately to pick up any graduate who does not comply. The Grad Nite Council reserves the right to employ a breathalyzer at its discretion.
4. Graduates will only be admitted between 8:30pm and 10:00pm on the evening of graduation. If you must arrive late or leave early, special arrangements must be made prior to June 17th with Amy Mattioli at cell (760) 815-0343.
5. If a graduate becomes unruly or graduate refuses to follow rules or chaperone instructions his or her parent will be called to remove the student.
6. Dress is casual, but in good taste. Wear your Grad Nite t-shirt and get extra raffle tickets.
7. **Graduates are not allowed to drive to and from Grad Nite.** Transportation to and from Grad Nite is the responsibility of the graduate's parent or guardian. Graduates must be dropped off and picked up by a licensed adult driver who is not an attendee.
8. **No backpacks or purses will be allowed.** Graduates' personal belongings will be placed in clear, gallon sized plastic ziploc bags during check-in. There will be room to check the plastic bag and a jacket or coat if desired. Graduates are encouraged to bring only essential items. Chaperones will have cell phones and no money is required.
9. Any items brought to Grad Nite are the sole responsibility of the graduate. SDAF, Grad Nite Council & volunteers will not be responsible for any loss or damage, even if items are checked.
10. All participants attending Grad Nite are subject to search.
11. Graduates will not be allowed to leave and return to Grad Nite once they have checked in.
12. Parents/Guardians will be notified no later than 11:00pm if their graduate fails to arrive at Grad Nite.
13. In the event of illness, graduates will **only** be released to the custody of a parent or guardian.
